KNIGHTDALE - 32 Degrees, a self-serve yogurt bar, opens at noon in the Shoppes at Midway center in Knightdale on Friday.

Until 6 p.m., 32 Degrees will be offering a buy one-get one free deal for students, school staff members and Knightdale Chamber of Commerce members, according to a press release.

"We are thrilled to be opening our first North Carolina store in the Knightdale community," said Jenny Buha, Director of Development and Marketing for 32 Degrees. "We want to come into the market with a bang and give customers a taste of what we are all about."

32 Degrees is located near the Five Guys burger joint.

The frozen treat shop offers customers 14 individual and ever-rotating flavors of yogurt, along with 50 different and always-changing topping such as hand-cut fresh fruit, candy, nuts and sauces.

Customers custom-assemble their own frozen treats, weigh their creation at the cash register and pay by the ounce. In addition to their regularly rotating selection of yogurts, 32 Degrees offers fat-free, kosher, no-sugar-added and low-sugar selections, the business says.

Flavors available on Friday include: Triple Chocolate, Cookies `n cream, Vanilla Bean, Sea-salted Caramel Pretzel, Wild strawberry, Blueberry tart, Birthday Cake, Firecracker, Watermelon sorbet, Italian style tart, Cotton candy, and Key Lime.

The store opens at noon everyday, and closes at 11 p.m. on Fridays and Saturdays and 10 p.m. Sunday through Thursday.
